Analysis of execution results of automation scripts to identify feature defects before these escape to field. Support QA team on validation of features using automation scripts and field reported issue reproduction. Define high-level test scenarios based on requirements and classify as positive, negative and boundary test cases. Create test cases with detailed steps as per high-level test scenarios and map to requirements. Identify potential test cases to be automated. Create the automated test scripts and evaluate for stability and performance. Create pipeline configurations for daily build creation and automated execution. Constantly improve automation coverage by automating test cases to achieve optimal test cycle. Create test report after detailed test pack execution and provide detailed defect summary for development and product teams.
